ESL Tidbits from WES ESL Teachers

Sometimes our students have trouble getting started in writing. 1. They may need support in choosing a topic, whether it's informative or narrative. Make sure they are clear on what they are supposed to write about and give them a few specific choices if needed. 2. Sometimes students may need to talk about the WHOLE story before they can start writing. Let them tell you or a friend what they are going to write. If they can't say it, they can't write it.

If you ever need resources for writing, let us know. Things like picture prompts, word banks, sentence frames, and graphic organizers can be an appropriate scaffold for our kiddos.

	Several of you have started reaching out to me with students hitting Step 5 on the Behavior Log and I've processed them as Incident Reports in eSchool. (Thank you!) My intent with each one is to follow up with the teacher that day - either in person or by email. If my day pops off and I overlook that, please hold me to that expectation and reach out.						
	Something that I can also do - especially if you are anticipating Little Johnny hopping to Step 5 on a given day - is a "check in" with the student at step 1. I'll swing by and have a little hallway pep talk about being Safe, Respectful, & Responsible. It has a way of communicating pretty clearly that the stakes are high now (especially after I remind them of the upcoming class parties) and may get ahead of them climbing that ladder.
