

1st Quarter:

- PLC: The Set-Up and Why(3 Big Ideas and 4 guiding questions)
 - Teams develop Norms and conflict resolution plan: Due September 9th
 - Teams “Unpack” Essential Standards: quarterly focus to being with aligned to scope and sequence
 - Establish our PLC Processes/Procedures/Roles: Weekly Planning Meeting
 - Develop A PLAN for the instructional cycle and grade level targeted intervention time(reflective planning, CFA development, assessment discussion process, and roles)
