

## Specific Actions to Increase Student Learning

Five Steps to Success in the PLC Journey

L. Commit that the fundamental purpose of the school is to ensure that

**ALL** students learn at high levels

- 2. Establish COLLABORATIVE TEAMS that take collective responsibility for student learning
- 3. Teams identify a guaranteed and viable curriculum for each unit, agree on common pacing guidelines, and create and administer COMMON FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS to monitor each student's learning at the end of each unit.
  - Utilize COMMON FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT data to identify:
  - Which students need additional time and support
    Which students need enrichment and extension
    Teachers who help students achieve at high levels so team
    members can examine those teacher's practices
- 5. Create a systematic **INTERVENTION PLAN** that guarantees that students who struggle receive extra TIME AND SUPPORT
