Mountain View Data Report

Over the past three years, the teachers at Mountain View Elementary have refocused their efforts to ensure that all students are learning at high levels. The State of Utah engages students in the Acadience Reading assessment as a benchmark screener three times each year. This assessment consists of subtests that can be used as universal screeners for early literacy skills and for progress monitoring that allows teachers to monitor the effectiveness of instruction and intervention. Each testing period we have an increase in nearly every area that surpasses our previous assessment period. Our Professional Learning Community is performing effectively and consistently improves their practices and student achievement.

The improvements in first and second grades are particularly encouraging. Mountain View's previous five years of Acadience data showed a decline each year in the percentage of students demonstrating proficiency from the Beginning of the Year (BOY) assessment to the End of Year (EOY) assessment. In first-grade there was a 1% increase in 2016. The decline for

2015 was -5%, in 2017 it was -12%, in 2018 it was -9%, and 2019 it was -5%. Second-grade's decline for 2015 was -13%, in 2016 it was -2%, in 2017 it was -10%, it was -9%, it was -10%. As the charts above show, we have changed this trend and are working together to ensure that each grade level is performing higher at EOY than BOY.

The State of Utah tracks the Pathways of Progress for every student from Beginning of the Year to the Middle of the Year (B-M) and from the Beginning of the Year to the End of the Year (B-E). Another evidence of our improvements as a school can be seen in the increasing percentage of students making typical or better progress on the Pathways of Progress report in each grade level.

The data below illustrates the difference in Mountain View Elementary's (MV) performance results from the 2018-2019 year to 2020-2021. The chart in green shows that MV was previously the lowest performing school in Box Elder School District (BESD) in nearly every category. The purple chart shows that MV made significant gains through the pandemic to perform in the average range of the schools in BESD. The pink chart shows the increase /decrease in the percent of students performing as proficient at each school in each assessment. Mountain View had the highest increase in each assessment. Despite the obstacles created by the pandemic, MV had an increase in every area and demonstrated more improvement than any other school in the district.

School's highlighted in yellow are Title I schools. Each of the other school's names were removed to focus on MV's results.
