Academic Letter Jacket Guidelines Tomball ISD

Objective: This award is to encourage and recognize students with outstanding performance in the area of academics.

One major award (Letter Jacket) is provided by the School District for each student that meets the lettering requirements for a given organization. Additional letters may be earned in other organizations upon completion of their lettering requirement. If a student becomes eligible for an additional award from the same organization, a bar will be made available for the student's jacket.

Academic letter jackets will be of the same color and type as jackets awarded through other school organizations. Students who are eligible for this award must make applications to the principal's office for official recognition.

A student may become eligible to receive an academic letter jacket from Tomball ISD if all of the following conditions are met during an individual school year starting at the freshman level of high school:

- The student must be enrolled in 7 or more credit yielding classes (including off-campus PE and state and local elective credits), which must include a Math, Science, Social Studies, and English Language Arts class.
- 2. The student must be enrolled in and complete at least two TAP, AP or DC level courses for the academic year.
- 3. The student must have a grade of 90 or above in every course at the end of each report card period for the entire school year as printed on the report card document. No extra points (Quality Points) are added for the first two advanced courses. Quality Points (up to 15 maximum points) however, may be added to additional advanced courses taken over two to meet the 90 average.

Or

4. A student may also meet eligibility for Academic Lettering if they meet their College, Career or Military Readiness (CCMR) measure prior to their Senior Year.
