Discipline 1: Focus on the Wildly Important

This is the discipline of focus. Exceptional execution starts with narrowing the focus -- clearly identifying what must be done. Otherwise, nothing else you achieve really matters much.

Literacy Team WIG

Decrease 7th-8th grade students identified as "not yet proficient" in ELA on the FAST test from 28% to 14% by winter FAST test.

Math Team WIG

Decrease 7-8 grade students identified as "high risk" in math on the aMath FAST Bridge assessment from 9% fall screening Sept. 1, 2021 to 4.5 % by winter screening 2021-2022.

Social Studies Team WIG

Decrease 7th-8th grade students identified as "not yet proficient" in ELA on the ISASP from 20% to 10% by June 1, 2022.

Science Team WIG

Decrease 7th-8th grade students identified as "not yet proficient" in ELA on the ISASP from 20% to 10% by June 1, 2022.

Related Arts Team WIG

Decrease 7th-8th grade students identified as "not yet proficient" in ELA on the ISASP from 20% to 10% by June 1, 2022.

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Discipline 2: Act on the Lead Measures

This is the discipline of leverage. 80% of your results will come from 20% of your activities -- are you focusing on the right ones? Discipline 2 is based on the principle that not all actions are created equal. Identify and act on the activities with the highest leverage.

Literacy Team Lead Measures

- Provide the interventions expected for assigned students each week
- Provide the progress monitoring expected for assigned students each week

Math Team Lead Measures

- Identify the students that are "high risk" in a spreadsheet
- Identify the STAGE each student falls in
- Meet with AEA for additional assistance

Science Team Lead Measures

- Read nonfiction articles weekly and administer comprehension quizzes monthly
- Determine which students need interventions to improve specific reading deficiencies using the data from the comprehension quizzes

Social Studies Team Lead Measures

- Read informational text and utilize reading strategies to answer questions
- Pull struggling students for Tiger Time after establishing a baseline

Related Arts Team Lead Measures

- Art: Journal weekly about artwork and progress
- Band: Implement 5 minutes of teacher prompted written reflection weekly
- Counseling: Implement "reflective thoughts" journals for tracking what students are presenting with upon coming to my office
- Physical Education: Write clear instructions on the board daily for students to get active as soon as they enter the gym

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Discipline 3: Keep a Compelling Scoreboard

This is the discipline of engagement. People and teams play differently when they are keeping score, and the right kind of scoreboards motivate the players to win.




Special Education Scoreboard




Social Studies Scoreboard
