

# Key Questions/Sentence Starters for Tutors

- What do you need to work on today?
- What is the most important thing for you to work on right now?
- What resources do you have for this class that can help you complete this work? (e.g. textbook, guided notes, notes from a lesson, examples, online texts, etc.)
  - In other words - How did you learn about this topic?
  - Let's take a look at that resource and see if we can figure it out.
- Let's look at your weekly "to-do" list (either from Academic Workshop or on Google Classroom.)
- Let's open up Google Classroom for your \_\_\_\_\_ class.
- Check Infinite Campus for \_\_\_\_\_ class to see if there is anything missing.
- Show me what you are working on in \_\_\_\_\_ class.
- What is your most successful class? What are you doing to achieve this success? How can you transfer that to this class?
- Can I help you get organized? Where do you keep track of homework? Do you use a planner?

## If students say...

1. I don't have anything to work on.
2. I'm completely finished with all my work.
3. I understand all my math (or other work).

## Tutors can say...

1. Okay, I'll just hang here for a bit in case you need me.
2. Okay, let's see what you completed in (Class x)
3. Okay, let's see what you're working on.  
Do a few more problems to show you understand.
