

Sample PLC SMART Goals 2022-2023

- **Earth Science**
Our focus will be to build reading of informational text skills in students enrolled at HHS during the 22-23 school year in Earth Science. Our target population will be students who have scored level 6 or below in comprehension of informational text on the Spring 2022 iReady. Our goal is for students to increase their MAP reading score a minimum of 1 point between Fall 2022 and Spring 2023.

- **World Language**
During the 2022-2023 school year, the World Language Department will work to close the HHS reading achievement gap by ensuring that 100% of all Level I and/or Level II World Language students who scored below a 70% on any vocabulary acquisition common assessment, with an emphasis on minority students and students with IEPs, will attend an intervention and show growth to a score of 70% or higher on a reassessment or subsequent assessment. The reading achievement gap data is collected through MAPS at the beginning of the school year. The team will check the standardized assessment data at the end of the 22-23 school year to review vocabulary and reading skills acquired throughout the year.

- **Social Studies Sophomore Team**
All students will demonstrate growth in their Maps reading scores from the Spring of 2022 to the Spring of 2023. Those who have already met competencies will show 1-2 points of growth. The middle $\frac{1}{3}$ of students not having met competencies will show 2-3 points of growth. Our bottom $\frac{1}{3}$ of students will show 3-4 points of growth. We will measure progress through stimulus based common assessments. Students who are struggling will receive appropriate assistance, based on individual needs during class or during enrichment.
