CONs: was not a very intentional time;; didn't meet the needs of all students;

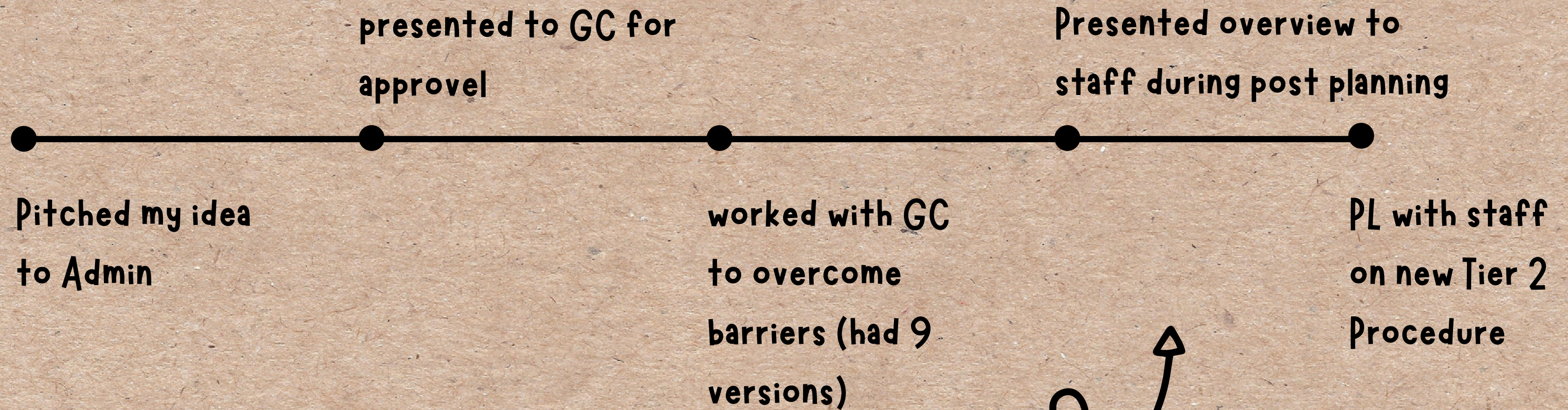

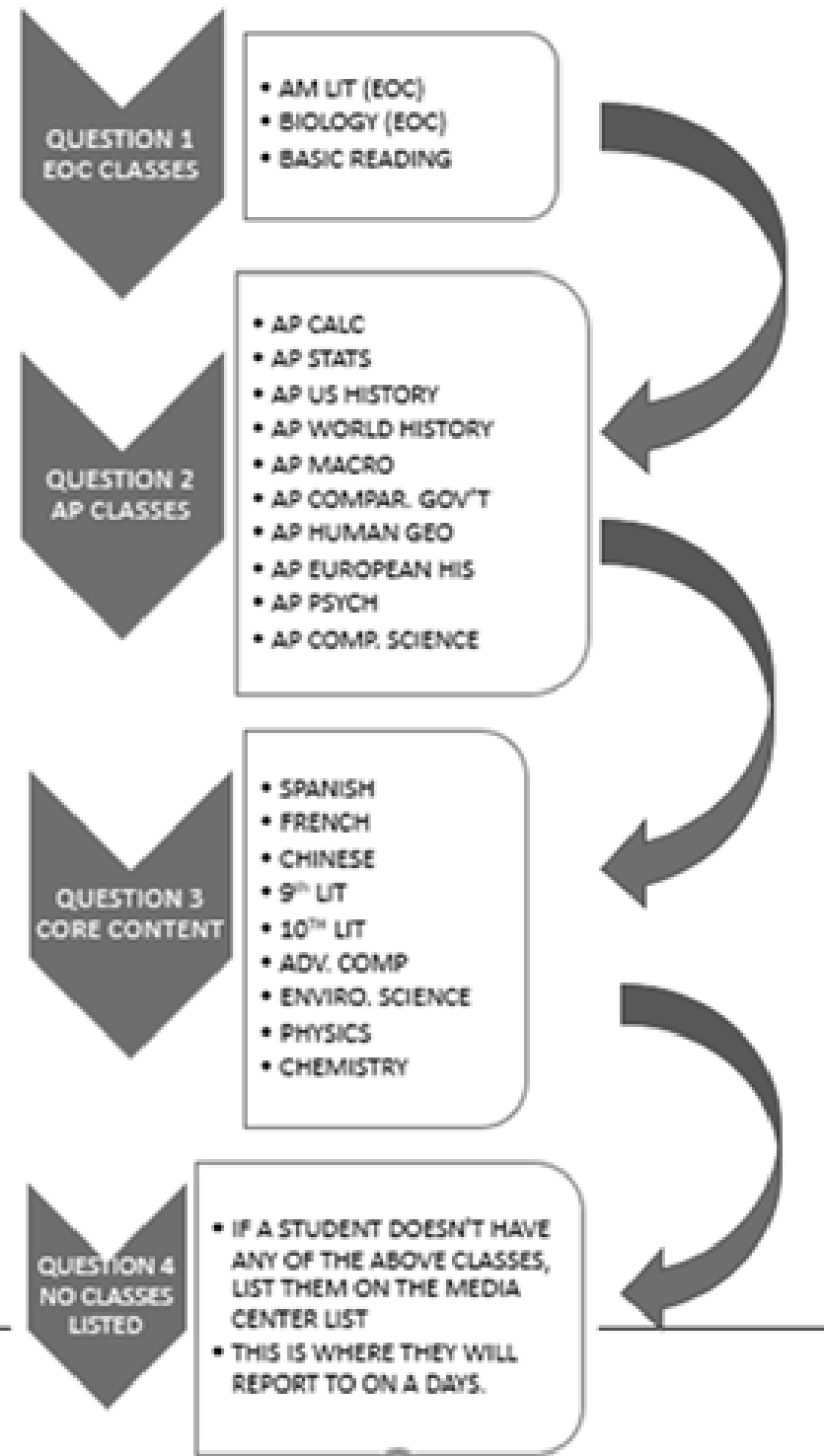

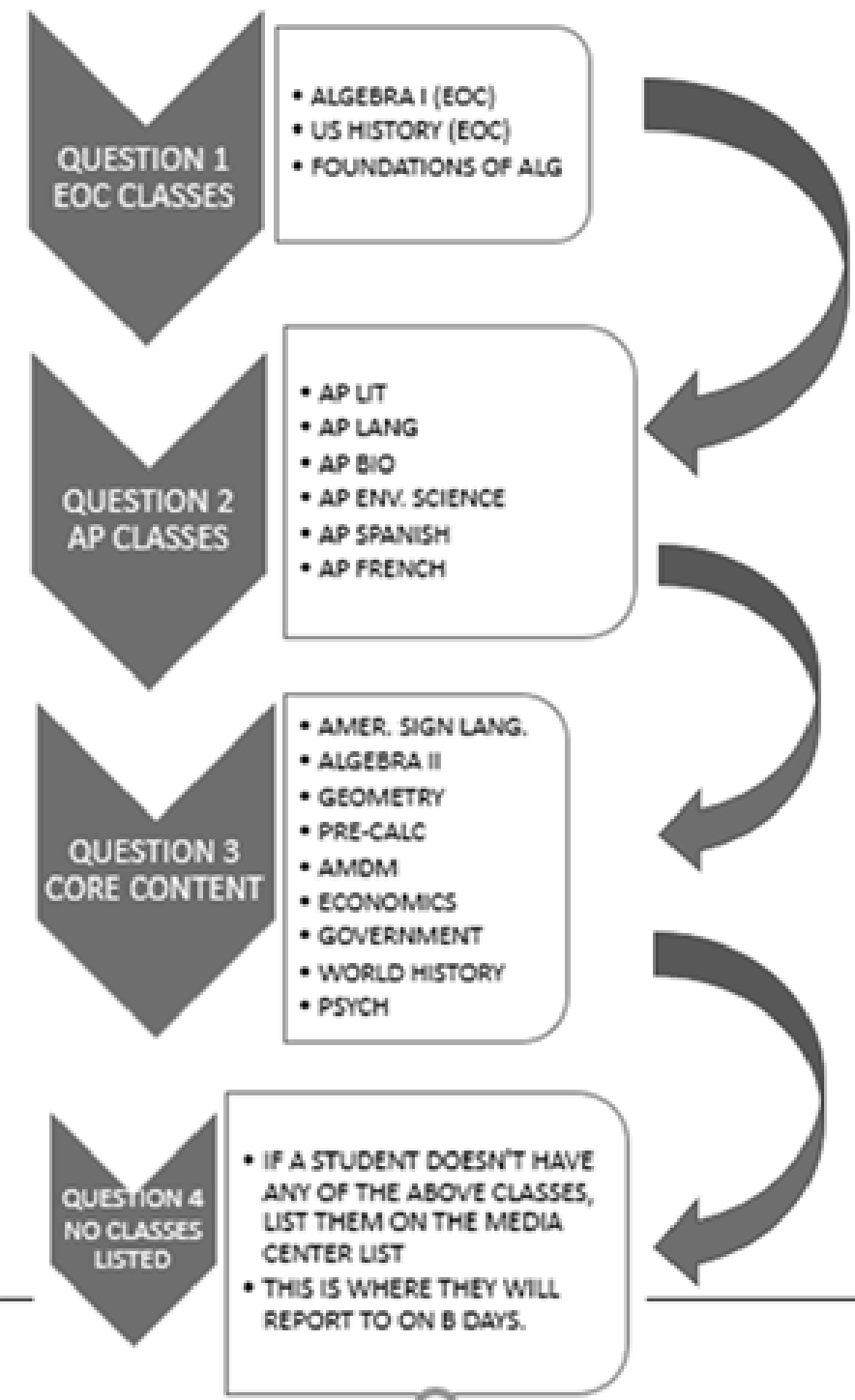

How will students and teachers know if they are to report to Tier 2 interventions or Study Hall?

- Teachers will go into the TEAMS document and fill in the student's name in **YELLOW** if they need Tier 2 interventions that week. Study hall teachers will look on the TEAMS document to find out who will be reporting to them. This is the roll that you will use to take paper attendance.

How will Turner pull students?

- Turner will select students based on RGM results. She will fill in the box with the student's name in **GREEN**. This means that they will report to her. She will not select students that have an EOC course.

How will Coach Dodd select students?

- Coach Dodd will work with the Student Will Committee to select "Will Students" that he will work with. He will fill in the box with the student's name in **RED**. If a student's name is in **RED**, they will report to the theater to work with Coach Dodd even if they need Tier 2 interventions (**RED** trumps all)

Can AP teacher's pull students out of study hall to work with them?

- Yes, the AP teacher would go into the TEAMS documents and if that student's box is white, they are able to pull that student to work with them. The AP teacher would fill in the student's name in **BLUE** to select them to work with. Those students would report to their AP teacher's room for interventions/extensions.
