2nd Grade Data Team Meeting Common Assessment Team Protocol Wednesday, September 12

The protocol is designed to help a teacher team quickly and efficiently discuss a common assessment. If each teacher reviews his or her own assessments data prior to the team meeting, then the team should be able to collectively complete this activity within a typical team meeting of forty-five to sixty minutes.

- 1. Which specific students did not demonstrate mastery on which specific standards? (Respond by the student, by the standard)
 - see attached list of students
- 2. Which instructional practices proved to be the most effective?
 - Touch math
 - Rocket math (memorizing facts)
 - Xtra math on the computer
 - Weekly timed tests
- 3. What patterns can we identify from the student mistakes?
 - Kids not counting on the correct way on a number line
 - Not counting touch dots
 - Not having facts memorized
 - Some kids did not understand two-digit addition
- 4. How can we improve this assessment?
 - No improvements needed at this time
- 5. What interventions are needed to provide failed students additional time and support?
 - Daily drill and practice (flashcards)
 - Weekly timed test
 - Xtra math on the computer
 - Touch dots
 - Model the correct way to count on using a number line
- 6. How will we extend learning for students who have mastered the standard(s)?
 - Provide math facts over 20
 - Solve word problems involving addition & subtraction
 - Xtra math on the computer
 - Introduce two-digit addition and subtraction (with and without regrouping)
