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Student Goal Setting

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3rd - 5th grade classroom teachers will conduct goal-setting and data tracking with each student on STAR 360 and STAAR-Formatted Assessments (weekly, classroom assessments and district assessments). These conversations should take place at a minimum of twice per month.

If we want our students to improve, we need to let them know where they're starting at, what their end goal is, and help them track their progress to get there.

Teachers will need to determine the data tracking forms they will use with their students. Once determined, a one-time blank copy of the form should be submitted to McNeill. **The deadline to submit data trackers is Monday, September 30th.**

We have previous STAAR data and BOY STAR 360 data. Each teacher should conduct a goal setting discussion with students within the next few weeks. For STAAR, students should know their previous STAAR result and have a goal set for the first Mini-Mock to be administered the week of October 7th. For STAR 360, students should know their BOY result and set a goal for their October STAR 360. (Remember, all students will log in to STAR 360 for reading and for math one time each month beginning in October.)

One idea would be to stagger goal-setting conversations. You could start with STAAR since the Mini-Mock is happening soon. Once you are through with the STAAR conversations, you could move to the STAR 360 conversations before the first October log-in. You could continue to alternate as a plan for having your two conversations per month. You are free to determine a system that works best for your class, as long as there are goal conversations twice a month focusing on STAAR and STAR 360.

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
