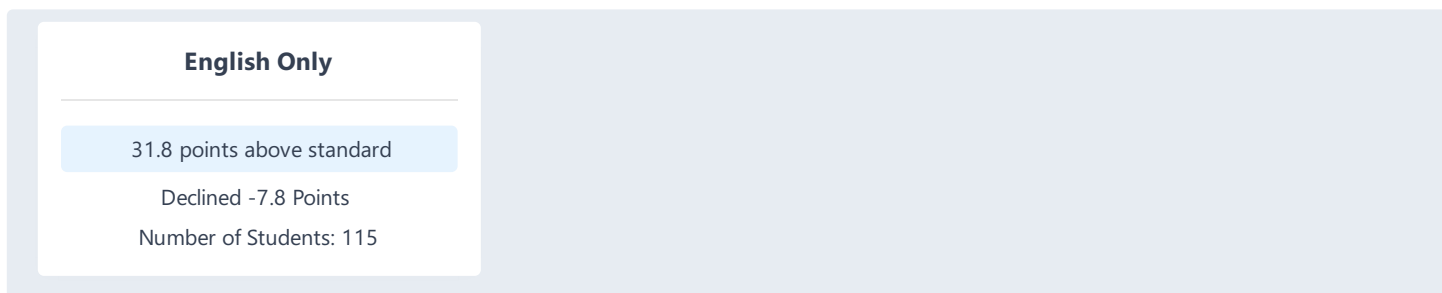
## Distance From Standard (English Language Arts)

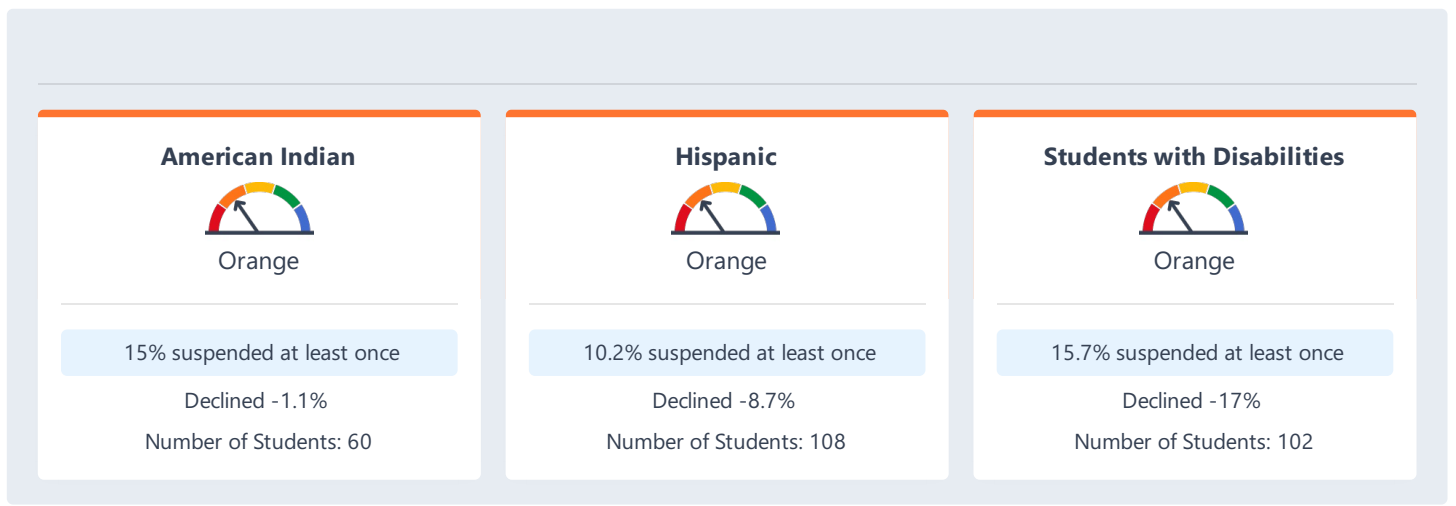
