Data Meeting Outline

To have a successful data meeting there needs to be clarity in the data and clarity in the expectations. Below are the expectations for teams when coming to data meeting:

- 1. Come with current reading levels within the last 2 weeks, **for students reading below level.** The assessments should be the same in each grade. Each grade level team decides on their measure, which include: CORE Phonics, QPAS, BAS, DIBELS, RISE, Reach for Reading, and grade level CFAs. All team members must use the same assessment to measure progress.
- Describe in detail what Learning Targets your team has been working on for the last 6 weeks in RTI time. This includes each teacher's group and what each teacher is working on.
- 3. What was your measure (assessment) of what Learning Targets students needed interventions, why are the students were split up the way they are, and why groups were given to a particular teacher.
- 4. What evidence has been created to show student improvement or not on the Learning Target?
- 5. Discuss each student who is still struggling on targeted interventions and any students below grade level in reading or at-risk. Please list all interventions that each student is receiving.
- 6. Identify next steps for the team. This would include instructional planning for Tier 1, and Tier 2 and Tier 3 Learning Targets (based on unpacked standards), and next steps for those students are who below reading levels.
