PARK PASS (Class)

- Teacher names by team on the office windows to keep track of class that is ahead
- PARK PASSES can be filled out by anyone at anytime and stars will be updated/moved weekly
- Gold, Silver, and Bronze Stars classes will be recognized on office windows
- Gold Star classes will receive KONA ICE at the end of the quarter
- PARK PASSES will be read each morning during announcements
- PARK PASSES will be returned you so you can display them in your rooms
- The office will also have a running tally.

CAUGHT BEING GOOD! (Individual)

- Each teacher will receive 150 on a pad (break apart into 25)
- 5 names will be drawn each month at the monthly assembly
- Prizes could include pencils, dc tshirt, sonic coupons, kona ice coupons, etc.
- The goal is that teachers hand out all 25 Caught Being Goods each month (one per day)
- Each teacher gets a pad that has 150 with the expectation of passing out approximately 25 each month
- We will order from quik print 50 pads with 150 sheets
- Junior Rangers can collect at the end of the day to eliminate kids coming to the office every time they get one

COLLECTION OF PASSES AND TICKETS

- Bins will be provided for your classroom labeled “CAUGHT BEING GOOD/ PARK PASS”
- Junior Rangers will come around once a day and collect any “Caught Being Good” AND “Park Passes” and bring them to the 4th Grade Hopper and 5th Grade Hopper.
- Junior Rangers will NOT interrupt your class to ask for them. If you don't have your bin by the door or easily accessible, your tickets and/or Passes will not be collected that day.
