

Detailed, Daily Lesson Plans

Lesson plans should be submitted weekly in Eduphoria: Forethought by Monday morning at 8 a.m. Plans should be detailed enough that another teacher could follow the plan and should specifically outline what will happen each day during instruction.

K- 2nd Grade

- Include a separate, daily planning box (or section) in Eduphoria/Forethought for each of the following according to assigned subject areas...
 - Word Study: Phonics / Heggerty's / Spelling
 - Reading
 - Writing / Grammar
 - Math
 - Science/Social Studies

3rd - 5th Grade

- Include a separate, daily planning box (or section) in Eduphoria/Forethought for each of the following according to assigned subject areas...
 - Reading
 - Writing / Grammar
 - Word Study: Phonics / Spelling
 - Math
 - Science
 - Social Studies

Include the following components for each subject area.

- **TEKS / ELPS**
- **Learning Target*** (*PLC Question #1 - What do we want students to learn?*)
- **Practice** (Guided Practice = "We Do" / Independent Practice = "You Do")
- **Assessment** (*PLC Question #2 - How will we know if they learned it?*)
 - On the Spot Assessments (Quick Checks / Exit Tickets) / Graded Work; or
 - Common Formative Assessment (CFA); or
 - Summative Assessment

*Learning Targets for lessons in each core subject area, written in kid-friendly language, will be posted in the classroom in a place and format that is easily visible and readable for all students.

For example:

- I can add two digit by two digit numbers.
- I can make inferences based on schema and text evidence.
