During our PLC meeting we discovered that a majority of students missed a certain question type. Going through the data we discovered which question(s) students struggled with. We are able to further discuss why and make adjustments for the rest of the day. Once we did this we saw great improvement in student scores.

This was the question that students struggled on, using the new type of STARR question with multiple blanks.

The idea was for students to get at least one blank correct and by knowing the story would be able to complete the remaining blanks. This was very much a higher order thinking question. In our PLC we discussed how this was a bit too complicated without giving the students more information. We agreed to stick with one or two blanks and fill in more information for students to be able to draw clues from.
