## EXPECTATION TIMELINE FOR PLC/BACKWARDS DESIGN/DATA

## Steps of Backwards Design:

- 1. Create a team folder:
  - a. Share link with your admin
  - b. Put the link for the folder in the curriculum planning document (found in PLC dashboard tab)
- 2. Complete the <u>essential learning chart</u> (found in PLC dashboard tab) for content
  - a. Keep completed copy in team folder
- 3. Use PLC Unit Design document (found in PLC dashboard tab) to deconstruct standards as a team for the upcoming unit.
  - a. Keep completed copy in team folder
- 4. Create <u>CFA</u> for unit (**Complete before you plan the lessons!**) If using a rubric for grading, the rubric should be included in the folder.
  - a. This should all be done at least 3 days before the unit starts.
  - b. Put copy in team folder for the specialist to review and give feedback.
- 5. <u>Plan activities/lessons</u> for unit that align to the CFA learning targets. Lesson plans can be done as a team or individually on the PLC Unit design document, on a separate document, or in a template on Eduphoria. However the method, the plans should be accessible in Eduphoria. <u>As you look at your prior year activities, please make sure they align to the targets you established!!! This is why you did all the work on the Essentials Chart and the Unit Design!!!</u>
- 6. Begin planning your next unit using the PLC Unit Design document (found in PLC dashboard tab)
- 7. Administer current unit CFA to students.
- 8. Meet with team and complete the data assessment document (found in the PLC dashboard tab) with CFA results
  - a. Completed data assessment in team folder
  - b. Put the link to the data assessment document in the curriculum planning document
  - c. Plan intervention and extension activities based on your data!
