The White River School District has a goal to have 90% of students reading at grade level in Kindergarten-2nd grade. The 90% Reading Goal includes Aimsweb data (scoring in the 50th percentile or above), Unit 4 district assessment data (1st and 2nd grade only), and with a District reading passage with comprehension questions. The district reading passage measure fluency rate, accuracy, prosody, and comprehension.

Rate expectations for district fluency probes in each grade:

Kindergarten: 19+ correct words per minute

1st Grade: 51+ correct words per minute

2nd Grade: 77+ correct words per minute

All accuracy expectations for district fluency probes is 95%.
