

K-2 Extension Examples

Guided reading

Description: Students receive guided reading instruction based on their reading level. We have many students that are reading above grade level based on their beginning of year benchmark assessment. Students are pulled weekly to receive extensions. At middle of year testing, those students grew a year in three months of instruction.

Seesaw

Our teachers use Seesaw to assign extensions to students that need extension during tier two intervention. Pictured you can see a kindergarten student that was assigned a different grade level math.

20-3= 17 10-5= 5 9-7= 2

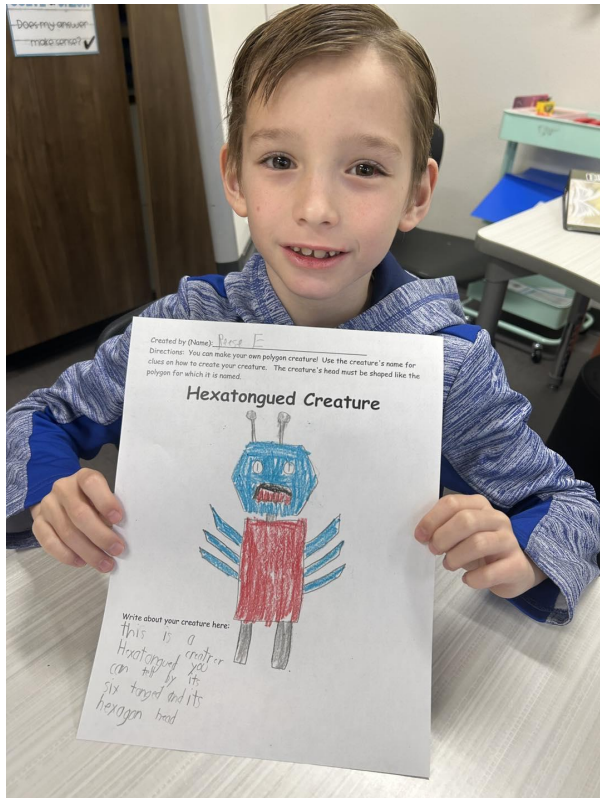
13-4= 9 16-6= 10 18-12= 6
