Reading Math

Your child will receive additional academic support/intervention with research-based, proven programs of Orton-Gillingham Phonics or Levelled Literacy Intervention for reading, Do the Math, Developing Number Concepts, or Strength in Number for math.

Small group instruction will be provided for your child during our scheduled intervention time (WIN - "What I Need" time) four times a week for 40 minutes a session. Our team continually reviews all available information to better assist your child in making successful progress in school. Throughout the additional academic support/intervention, progress monitoring measures will be collected. These groups are fluid, so when an instructional cycle is complete (usually about six weeks), we will pre-assess for next steps and determine the best course for your child. Student data is available to you at your request any time, and will be provided for you quarterly with reports cards.

We consider your student's academic achievement in school a top priority. Interventions are designed to improve academic success. You will find an MTSS parent information sheet included with this letter to provide you with more information.
