Weekly Choice Board

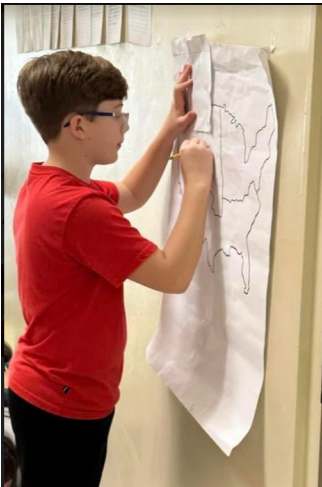

Social Studies Example



Description: Students created maps that portrayed sectionalism in the United States. Students created illustrations to represent the main features of each region (economy, transportation, crops/goods, lifestyles, political values, social structures, etc.).

Description: Students picked out any logo and created a large scale drawing using a grid. They were given different scale factors at random to create their image.

Description: Students in Advanced Math completed a financial literacy activity where they had to balance a budget based on different jobs, utility payments, number of children, life events, etc. Students were allowed to choose their own profession, but were given random life events and had to make decisions on how to balance their budget. This whole class participated in the activity.
