

The “Boynton School: Achievement Data” chart shows the percentage of Boynton Elementary School students that outperforms the system and state in the areas of Reading, Science, and Social Studies in all three documented years at all grade levels represented in third, fourth, and fifth. This document states the percentage of students that are performing at the proficient or extinguished stage.

The only areas where Boynton Elementary did not meet district or state benchmarks in Math were in the 2016-2017 school year, students did not perform above the district benchmark but did outperform the state in third grade and fifth grade math.

In 2017-18 Boynton did exceed the district and state benchmarks.

In 2018-19 Boynton Elementary fell behind in Math in third grade and fifth grade.

The “Achievement Data: Analysis for Trends” chart shows how each cohort group developed over three consecutive years.

Following each group of students, we have found there is an overall positive trend for each group in Language Arts. Math increased from 2016-17 to 2017-2018 but decreased in 2018-2019. However, this was also a decrease in the county and state.
