## BUILDING GOALS

1. Westview Elementary School will increase reading scores for students scoring proficient or advanced by 5 percentage points - from 53% to 58%.
2. Westview Elementary School will increase mathematics scores for students scoring proficient or advanced by 4 percentage points - from 66% to 70%.
