To identify quality instructional practices that support quality student learning. So that changes could be made based on those identified instructional practices.

#### **Protocol Summary**

Describing data without judgement or interpretation

Then find out what the data suggests - looks at trends/draw any conclusions-did the data really test what you wanted students to learn?

How does this data support teaching and assessment in the future?

### **Purpose**

Did the data really show what the assessment's purpose? Di it assess what you wanted students to learn? How solid was the assessment?

### Appoint a Devil's Advocate

**Protocol Summary** 

Appoints one person to raise different points of view without fear of retribution.

**Purpose** 

To provide a safe place for someone to "play devil's advocate".

Collaborative Culture

#### Question Focus (Q1, Q2, Q3, or Q4)

Any depending on the need of the team or students.

### **Protocol Summary**

Identify assumption and discuss the WHY to that outcome. When all voices are heard in a round robin fashion, move forward and create a plan of action. Assume the assumption is an idea.

#### **Purpose**

To discuss a multitude of issues around what to teach, how to teach it, and how to assess it. Can be used before planning to determine essential learnings or to problem solve if differing views come up.

Q1- What do we expect students to learn? How will we respond... (Q3 & Q4)

#### **Protocol Summary**

Looking at data through a lens outside of your viewpoint. I.e. what would the grade level above or below view your data? Or How would a specialist view this data? How would somebody outside of the building view this data?

#### **Purpose**

When would you want to use this? When you want to double check assumptions or for cross-grade level perspectives or self analysis on rigor of standards. Could be used to challenge group think in your PLC.

### Forming Ground Rules (Creating Norms)

**Protocol Summary** 

Identify individual needs, limit ground rules to 10, and check for consensus.

**Purpose** 

To create norms for working productively in a group, especially related to difficult issues. To clarify expectations and build trust.
