School SMART Goals

Four School-Wide SMART Goals for the Annual
School Plan

SMART GOAL #1

Reading Goal:

Using the iReady Diagnostic Reading Assessment, 60% of the students in grades 1-8 will reach the annual typical growth mark in Reading.

SMART GOAL #2

Math Goal:

Using the iReady Diagnostic Math Assessment, 60% of the students in grades 1-8 will reach the annual typical growth mark in Math.

SMART GOAL #3

Chronic Absenteeism Goal:

During the 2020-2021 school year, Sovereign Ave. School will decrease the percentage of chronic absenteeism from 11.2% to 8%.

SMART GOAL #4

Social Emotional Learning Goal:

By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, 60% of teaching staff at Sovereign Avenue School will implement at least 3-4 evidence-based strategies as contained in the social emotional learning scope and sequence as measured by an implementation checklist.

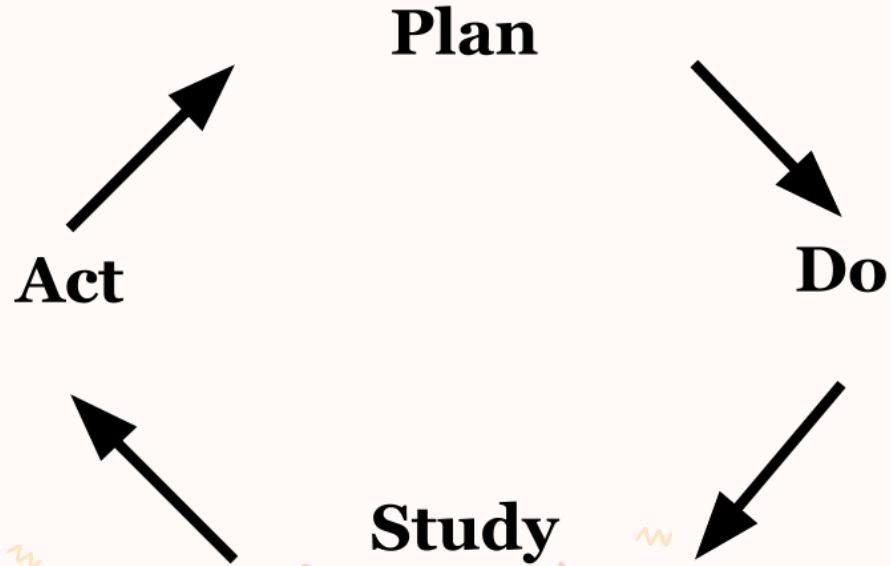
