## Third Grade's SMART Goal...






Our Goal: By May, 73% of students will be at standard in multiplication facts as measured by a timed test and discussion/observation in RTI groups.

Our Reality: 63/118 (53%) kids in third grade are proficient in their multiplication facts (87% and above).

Fifth Grade's SMART Goal...

Our Goal: By March 7th, 100% of students will be at standard for the learning



target of adding and subtracting fractions.

Our Reality: 95% of students are at standard after our Tier I instruction. In order to reteach the 6 students who did not reach standard, we will create a small group during UA time.




Kinder SMART Goal...

Our Goal: By March 15, 80% of our students will be at or above standard with their ability to read sight words.

Our Reality: 69% of our students are currently at or above standard with their ability to read sight words.

Fourth Grade SMART Goal...

Our Goal: By the end of the April 2019, 20% of students (unweighted) will be at or above grade level (based on a rubric score of 4), using a common assessment, Slower Than the Rest by Cynthia Rylant, for understanding theme in a story.



Our Reality: 7% of students are currently at or above grade level in this focus area, prior to instruction, as based on a pretest.

First Grade SMART Goal....

Our Goal: By the end of May, 2019, 75% of students will be at standard in phoneme substitution as measured by the PAA Hard Card.



Our Reality: 50% of students are currently at or above standard in this area as measured by the Hard Card.



Second Grade SMART Goal...

Our Goal: By the end of May, 50% of our students will be at standard in story retell as measured by a

common story mapping assessment.

Our Reality: 30% of students are currently at standard in this area as measured by a pre-assessment.
