2022-23 Windsor Central Middle School Goals

1. In order to achieve 82% of students meeting or exceeding nationally-normed literacy levels, we will move 11 students from “below-average” in reading to “average”; and in order to achieve 85% of students meeting or exceeding nationally-normed math fluency levels, we will move 33 students from “below-average” in math fluency to “average” (as measured by AIMSWeb).
2. Increase the district graduation rate by increasing Process Criteria Skills of identified “at-risk” students by 25% (as measured by our 4-point Report Card rubrics).
