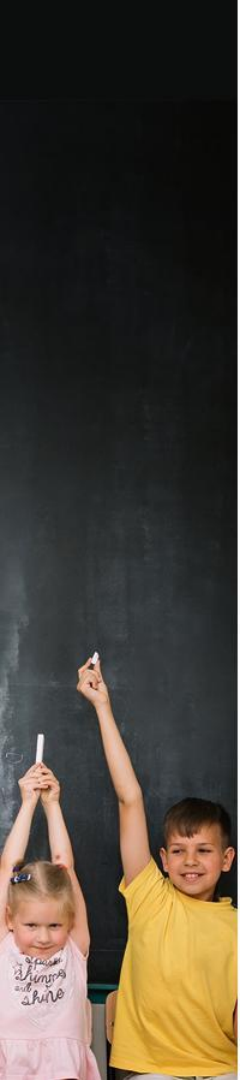
Standards Comparison and Trajectory

WSE Writing Templates

- Discuss
 - grade appropriate
 - common trajectory
- Create
 - opinion
 - informational
 - narrative



Writing Prompts

- *BOY Writing Prompt by 8/30*
 - teacher scores using BOY rubric
- *EOQ Writing Prompts (CFA)*
 - based on Essential Standards & Curriculum Map
 - by EOQ and assess grade using WSE/Milestones rubric (CFA protocol)
 - submit prompts in GL Shared Drive > Writing Folder
- *Students place all writing prompts in Leadership Notebook w/ rubric (Writing Tab)*
